



1. Open iTunes and click **Sign-in**







2. If you already have an iTunes account, enter it below. If now, click the **Create New Account** button.

	<p>5. Click Submit a Podcast</p> <p>6. ALT-TAB to your browser and connect to Gcast</p>

	<p>7. Open your Gcast account, and click the XML link next to the channel you wish to add to iTunes.</p>
	<p>8. With the address highlighted, press CTRL-C to copy.</p>

	<p>9. Paste the link into the Podcast Feed line and click Continue</p>
