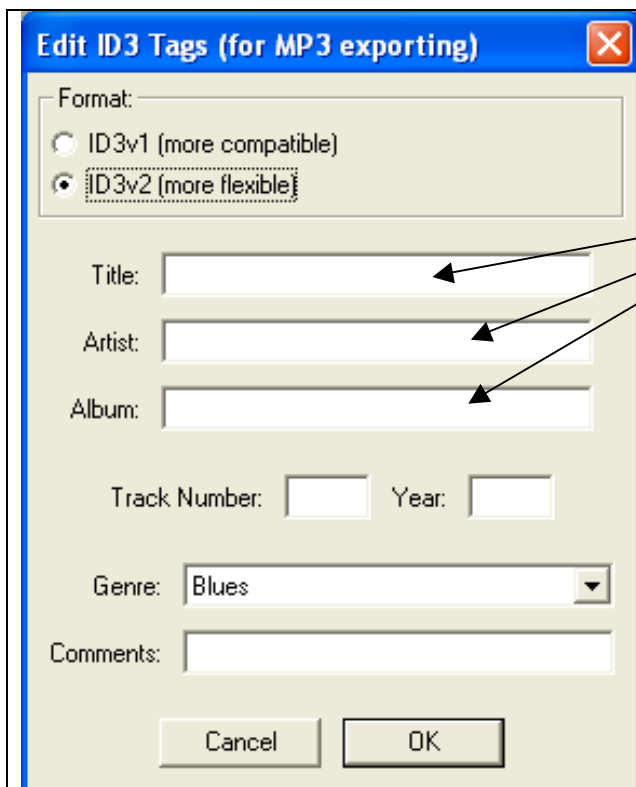

Adding Podcast Tags and Pictures

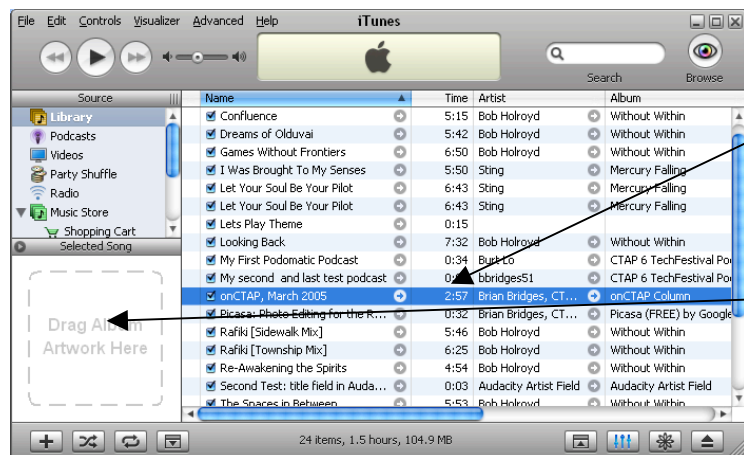

From Audacity, pull down the **Project** menu and select **Edit ID3 Tags**

These ID tags become the **song name**, **artist**, and **album** in the iTunes Library.

Pull down **File** and choose **Export as MP 3**



There are two ways to add a picture to a Podcast. Here's the easiest.

Start **iTunes** and Drop your MP3 into main window.

Select your podcast

In the lower left corner, find the **Now Playing/Selected song** window.

Click the header so that the window says "**Selected Song.**" (notice the window says "**Drag Album Artwork here.**")

Find your artwork and drop it in the window. Drag your podcast back out of iTunes.

However, when you drag the file OUT of iTunes, the file name will be changed to the Title listed in your ID3 tag. Change the file name back to something simpler.
